
## A note about the data

## Navigation notes

**Trevor to Llangollen:** From Trevor to Llangollen the canal is very shallow, accentuating the flow down-stream. It is not recommended for boats drawing more than 21 inches. It is also, in places very narrow.

**Pontcysyllte Aqueduct;** and  
**Whitehouse Tunnel;** and  
**Chirk Tunnel;** and

**Chirk Aqueduct:** Do not enter if a boat is approaching from the opposite direction. Wait until it is clear.

- 2 Llangollen Services:** Water, Elsan disposal, toilet, refuse disposal.
- 4 Trevor (Anglo-Welsh):** Water, pump-out, refuse disposal, shop, diesel.



## River Dee branch

**Length:** 21.95m (72ft)

**Headroom:** 2.34m (7ft 8")

## Visitor moorings

- 1 Llangollen:** There are visitor moorings both on the towpath (360m length) and in the new 32-berth basin, which includes water and electric supplies. During the summer months there is a mooring attendant present. There is a charge and the maximum stay is 48 hours. Tel: 03030 404040 for more information. Boaters can stay free up to 4pm and staff are on site until approximately 8pm to take bookings. There is no pre booking service.
- 3 Sun Trevor:** Maximum 14 days. Total 90 metres. Picnic tables.
- 4 Trevor Basin:** Maximum 14 days. Total 100 metres.
- 5 Froncysyllte:** Maximum 14 days.
- 6 Cefn Buchan Lift Bridge:** Maximum 14 days.
- 7 Cefn Buchan:** Maximum 14 days.
- 9 Chirk Bank:** Maximum 14 days. Total 140 metres.
- 10 Poachers Pocket:** Maximum 48 hours. Total 100 metres.



## Navigation notes

### Montgomery Canal

**Frankton Junction to Maesbury:** The canal is also navigable for trailed boats on the isolated section between Arddleen and Berriew. Slipways are situated at Welshpool car park and at the Wern.

### Llangollen Canal

**Ellesmere Tunnel:** Do not enter if a boat is approaching from the opposite direction. Wait until it is clear.

**5 Ellesmere Services:** Water, Elsan disposal, toilet, refuse disposal, picnic tables, pub, information.

**9 Bettisfield facilities:** Water, refuse disposal.

### Montgomery Canal

**12 Weston Arm Services:** Water, toilet, refuse disposal, picnic area, parking.




### Llangollen Canal

- 1 New Marton:** Total 60 metres.
- 2 Hindford:** Total 90 metres.
- 3 Ellesmere, from service station - Br 60:** Maximum 72 hours. Total 925 metres. Picnic tables.
- 4 Ellesmere Arm:** Maximum 72 hours.
- 6 Blakemere:** Maximum 14 days.
- 7 Colemere:** Total 140 metres. Picnic tables.
- 8 Hampton Bank:** Total 150 metres. Picnic tables.
- 10 Frankton Junction:** Maximum 14 days.

### Montgomery Canal

- 11 Frankton Locks:** Maximum 48 hours.
- 13 Weston Arm:** Maximum 48 hours.

- 10 Grindley Brook Services:** Water, Elsan disposal, pump-out, shower, refuse disposal, picnic tables, pub, information.

### Shropshire Union Canal

- 14 Barbridge:** Water, refuse disposal.

### Llangollen Canal

- 1 Burland, Br 3-6:** Maximum 48 hours.
- 3 Baddiley Hall:** Maximum 14 days.
- 4 Wrenbury Heath:** Maximum 14 days.
- 5 Wrenbury Church:** Maximum 14 days.
- 6 Wrenbury Frith:** Maximum 14 days.
- 7 Marbury:** Total 50 metres. Picnic tables.
- 8 Quoisleigh:** Maximum 14 days.
- 10 Grindley Brook:** Maximum 48 hours. Total 325 metres. Picnic tables.
- 11 Whitchurch, between lift bridge and winding hole:** Maximum 48 hours.
- 11 Whitchurch offside, east of lift bridge:** Maximum 14 days.
- 12 Tilstock:** Maximum 48 hours. Total 125 metres. Picnic tables.
- 13 Whixall 'stop & shop':** Total 125 metres.

### Middlewich Branch

- 15 Cholmondeston:** Maximum 48 hours. Total 300 metres.

### Shropshire Union Canal

- 14 Barbridge:** Maximum 24 hours. Total 140 metres.
- 17 Hurlleston:** Maximum 48 hours. Total 180 metres. Picnic tables.

## Navigation notes

### Shropshire Union Canal

**Ellesmere Port to Nantwich:** Navigation should be possible for boats of up to 75ft 2in length, but please consult the waterway office first.

Broad boats up to around 13ft 6in beam can access this section via the River Dee Branch, but cannot pass under the M53 into Ellesmere Port.

All locks except Beeston Iron Lock are at least 14ft wide. Beeston Iron Lock (13ft 5in) is distorted and two narrowboats are recommended not to share: if they do, they must keep well back from the bottom gates.

At the M53 bridges (146a and 147a), the narrowest point is 10ft 11in.

## Locks & bridges

### Llangollen Canal

**Grindley Brook Staircase Lock 1; and Grindley Brook Staircase Lock 2; and Grindley Brook Staircase Lock 3:**

To ensure your visit to Grindley Brook is a pleasant one, we aim to have Volunteer Lock Keepers present to support your passage through the staircase locks. Our Lock Keepers operate between March and October at peak times. If you require their assistance, they will be happy to help. Please note, at busy times, delays are to be expected.

**Bridge 20, Wrenbury Lift Bridge:** Canal & River Trust key required. Electric lift bridge.
